### **Exams Results Summary 2018– 2019**

Students at Seven Hills School have the opportunity to take a range of accredited courses including Entry Level qualifications, ASDAN and AQA Unit Awards. Additionally, cross curricular awards including the Lord Mayors Award and the Duke of Edinburgh Award are taken by students in the lower and upper school.

Accreditation is centered on upper school students from Y9 to Post 16; however, some of our more able students begin Entry Level qualifications for English and Maths in the lower school.

Highlights for the year:

- 22 Y7/8 students achieved the Lord Mayors Award and met the Lord Mayor to receive certificates and badges. 13 students at Level 1 and 9 students at Level 2.
- 11 Y11 students achieved the Bronze award from the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme.
- 11 Y11 students achieved Entry Level Certificate in Physical Education.  
Entry Level 1 – 2 students, Entry Level 2 – 8 students, Entry Level 3 – 1 student
- 15 Y10/11 students have been entered for Entry Level qualification in Personal & Social Education. (Results will be available in October).
- Students across the school achieved Functional Skills Entry Level in Maths, English and ICT. Maths – 19 students, English – 22 students and ICT – 33 students.  
27 students are currently working towards completing either English Entry Level 1, 2, 3
- 11 students achieved the Arts Award – Explore
- 34 Post 16 students gained between one and three ASDAN modules from the Towards Independence programme.
- 125 students across the school gained 447 AQA Unit Awards across a range of subjects and challenges.
- 15 students have been entered for AQA Personal and Social Education – Results pending
